NOTE: wristbands will not be issued to any unregistered drivers.

DRIVER MEETING: There will be a mandatory driver meeting in the classroom on Tuesday morning at 8:00am.

**HOURS:** The open track/open pit lane. will be hot from 8:30am until 4:30pm each day with a break for lunch from 12:00pm until 1:00pm.
