**REGISTRATION:** Will take place in the classroom, under the pit lane garages in the North Paddock, on Wednesday morning from 7:00am and will close **promptly** at 7:55am. You will be required to sign our Release and Waiver of Liability and Indemnity Agreement and will then be issued an event windshield sticker and a driver wristband. NOTE: wristbands will not be issued to any unregistered drivers.

## **DRIVER MEETING:** There will be a mandatory driver meeting in the classroom on Wednesday morning at 8:00am.

**HOURS:** The open track/open pit lane. will be hot from 8:30am until 4:30pm each day with a break for lunch from 12:00pm until 1:00pm. Drivers who have registered for our "unrestricted passing" option will also have access to the track from 4:30pm to 5:30pm.

**TIRE SERVICE:** Mounting/balancing services will be provided by Frisby Tire (<u>www.frisbyracetire.com</u>). Please contact Derek Schaefer by email (<u>derek@frisbyracetire.com</u>) or by phone (702)433-7390 to order tires for delivery to the track.

**FUEL:** Self-service Sunoco fuels (both leaded and unleaded) are available at the fuel island in the North Paddock for purchase by credit card only.

**RETAIL STORE:** The TMI Autotech retail store is located in at the end of the concession building nearest to the fuel island.

**FOOD:** The Pagoda Grill, in the paddock, will be open for breakfast and lunch from 7:00am until 2:00pm. Connie's Pub and The Oak Tree Tavern will be open during our event starting at 6pm.

**TRACK DAMAGE:** Drivers are financially responsible for any damage that they cause to race track property including, but not limited to, tire barriers, guard rails and posts.
