LOAD IN PARKING: Tuesday, August 29, specific time to follow.

PADDOCK ACCESS/GARAGES: The paddock will be open to DMTD participants on Tuesday, August 29. Garage assignments will be attached. There is no overnight camping and the facility will be closed at 10:00pm each night. If you are towing to the event and have an assigned garage, please park directly in front of your assigned garage bay. Do not obstruct fire lanes. If you do not have an assigned garage, please park anywhere in the South Paddock.

DMTD EVENT REGISTRATION: Will be held in the Great Room of the Media Center on Wednesday morning from 7:00am and will close **promptly** at 7:55am. You will be required to sign our Release and Waiver of Liability Agreement and will then be issued a wristband and event windshield sticker.

DRIVER MEETING: There will be a **MANDATORY DRIVER MEETING** in the Great Room at 8:00am on Wednesday.

GARAGE AREA PROTOCOL: No fueling, or storage of fuel, is permitted in the garages. Direction of travel around the garage is counter-clockwise only. This applies to all vehicles including pit bikes, tugs, street cars, etc. There is no smoking in the garages.

HOURS: The track will be hot from 8:30am until 4:30pm each day with a break for lunch from 12:00pm until 1:00pm.

PASSING: Is permitted anywhere on the race track. **PASSING PERMISSION (“POINT BY”) IS MANDATORY IN CORNERS** and, though strongly encouraged, is optional on straights.

TIRE SERVICE/RETAIL/ON-SITE SHOP: THE LITTLE SPEED

SHOP (www.thelittlespeedshop.com) is a full service race facility located at the south end of the garages at WGI. Contact Kevin Vanvalkenburgh at (585)205-8090 or stop by the shop during our event.

FUEL: Self-service fuel (both leaded and unleaded) is available at the fuel island for purchase by credit card only each day from 8:30am until 3:30pm.



Link to order fuel delivered to track is on our website home page under “Track Days” menu.

NUMBERS: Are mandatory for all vehicles on the race track. Numbers must be at least 10” high on each side of the vehicle and 6” high on a vertical surface at the rear of the vehicle. You will not be allowed access to the race track without a conforming set of numbers.

TRACK DAMAGE: Drivers are financially responsible for any damage that they cause to race track property including, but not limited to, tire bundles, guard rails and posts. Additionally, any absorbent material used to clean up after fluid spills, leaks, etc. and/or any fire suppression used on your behalf

will be billed back to the driver of the car. WGI has informed us that, if a comprehensive cleanup is necessary due to a significant fluid spill, the charge will be **\$500 per hour**.
